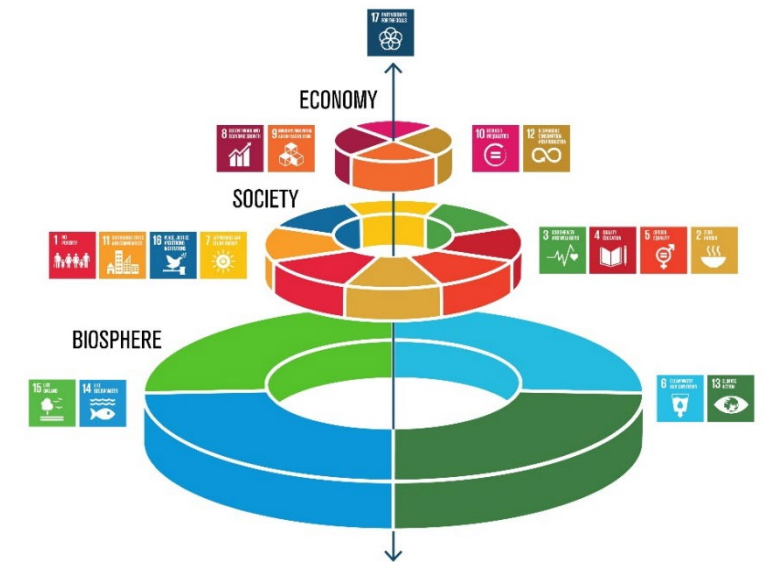

(ASE-ABS, UvA EB-UvA faculties, UvA-EB-society)



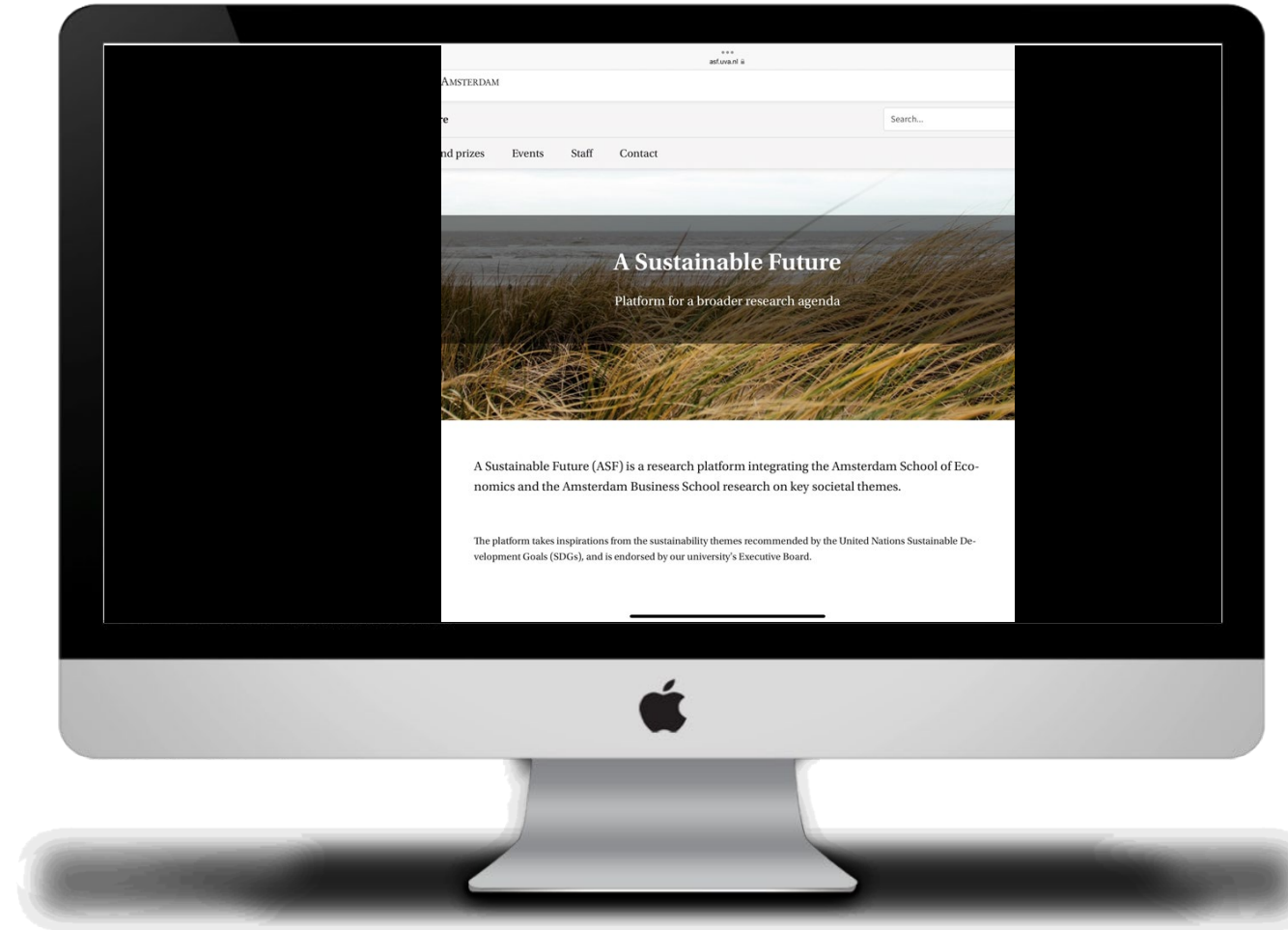

New call! 6th ASF Call for research grants





6th ASF Call for research grants

- Budget: 100k euro
- **Deadline: January 9, 2023**
- Submission: Via ASF website (link to submission system)
- Typologies:
 1. **Cross-school (and across faculties) research applications:** up to Euro 15K. Preference to EB junior faculty members (PhD students, Post-docs, tenure-track assistant professors, level II associate professors) as PI.
 2. **Junior faculty research applications:** up to 10K Euro. EB junior faculty members only.
 3. **General applications (including teaching and outreach):** up to 10K Euro.
- Two-thirds of the total budget will be dedicated to cross-school and junior faculty applications
- Evaluation report after 2 years from the date of acceptance required
- Decision: by February 10th, 2023

6th ASF Call for research grants

- Evaluation criteria:
 1. Quality of the proposal (45%):
 - a. Relevance of the problem;
 - b. Innovative character (e.g., new concepts or theory, methods, new data);
 - c. Feasibility of the research plan
 - d. Societal impact of the proposal.
 2. Fit with the ASF Goals (40%)
 3. Efficient use of the amount of money requested (15%)
- Decision process:
 - ASF Scientific Committee, confirmed by the EB Dean, and ABS and ASE Research Directors.
 - Reject, Reject & Resubmit, Part grant, Full grant. Applying for top-up funding is possible in one of the next grant rounds
- Spring 2023, 7th Call for research grants

Share per school	ABS: 33, ASE: 27 cross-school: 4 cross-faculty: 5

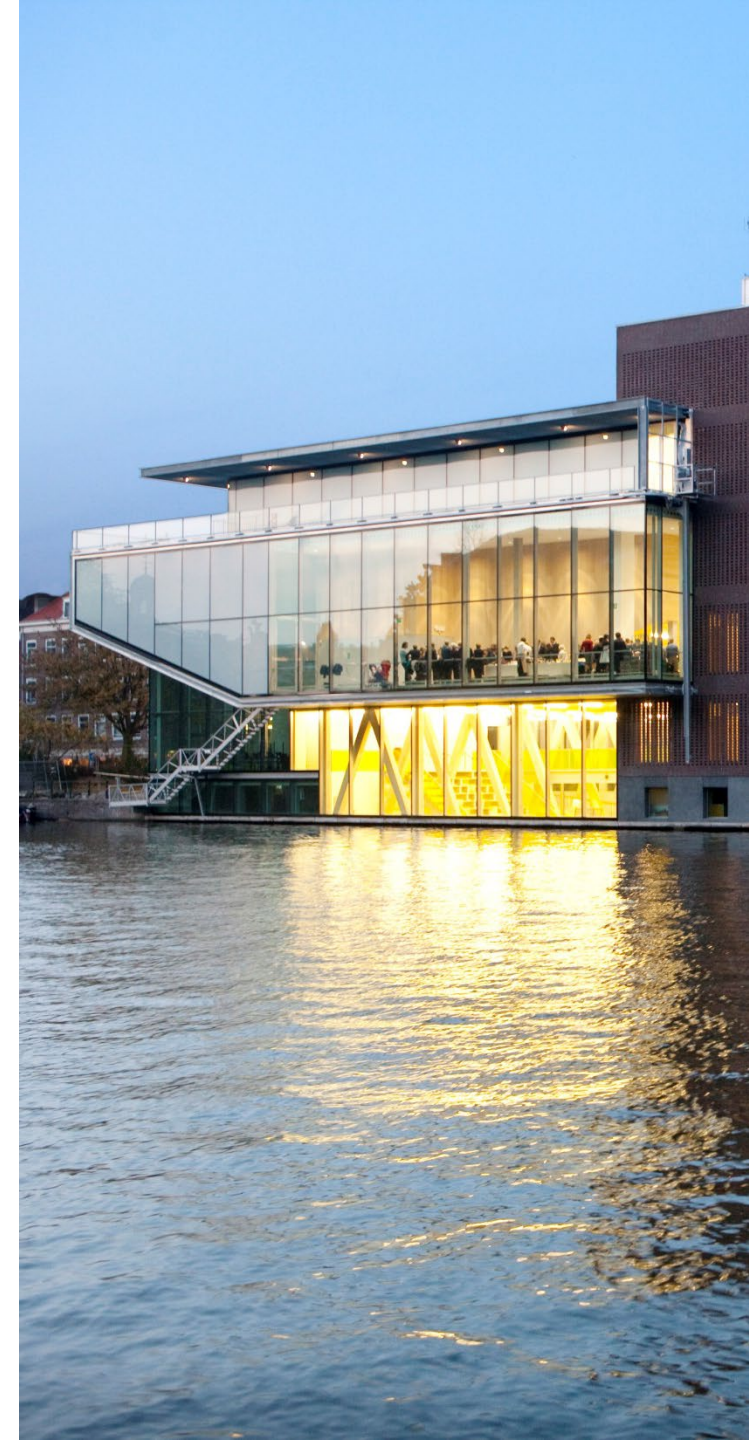

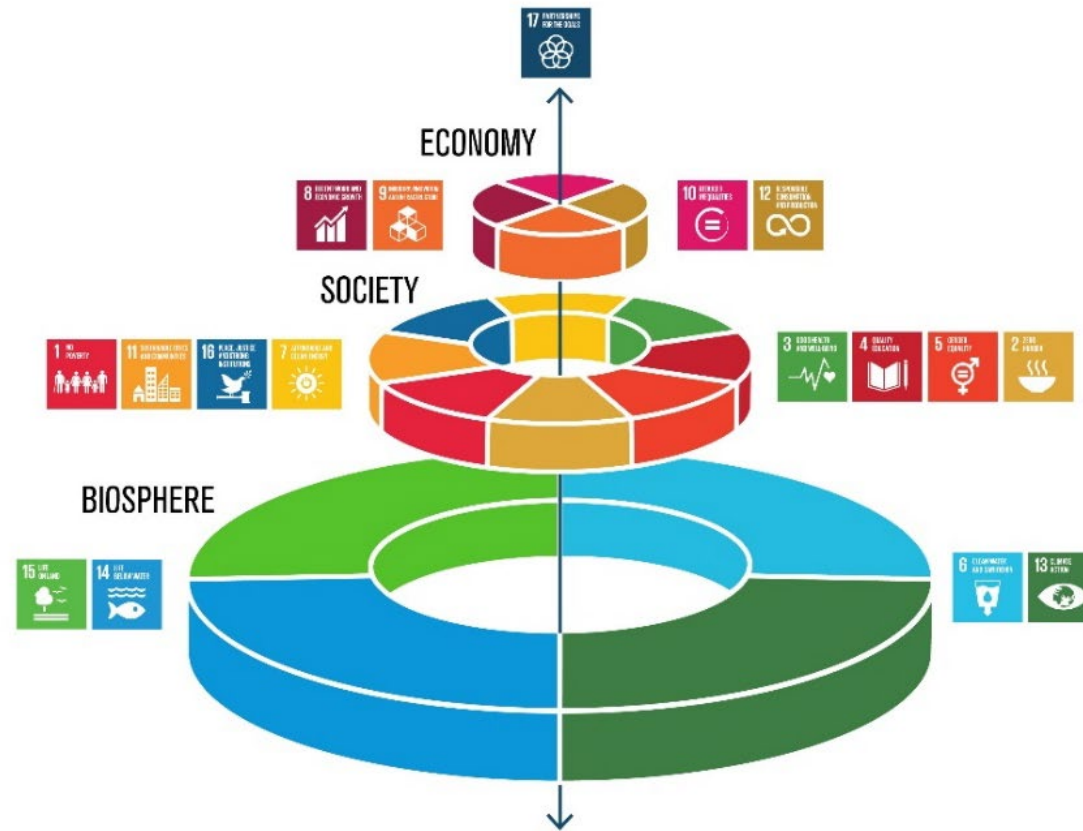

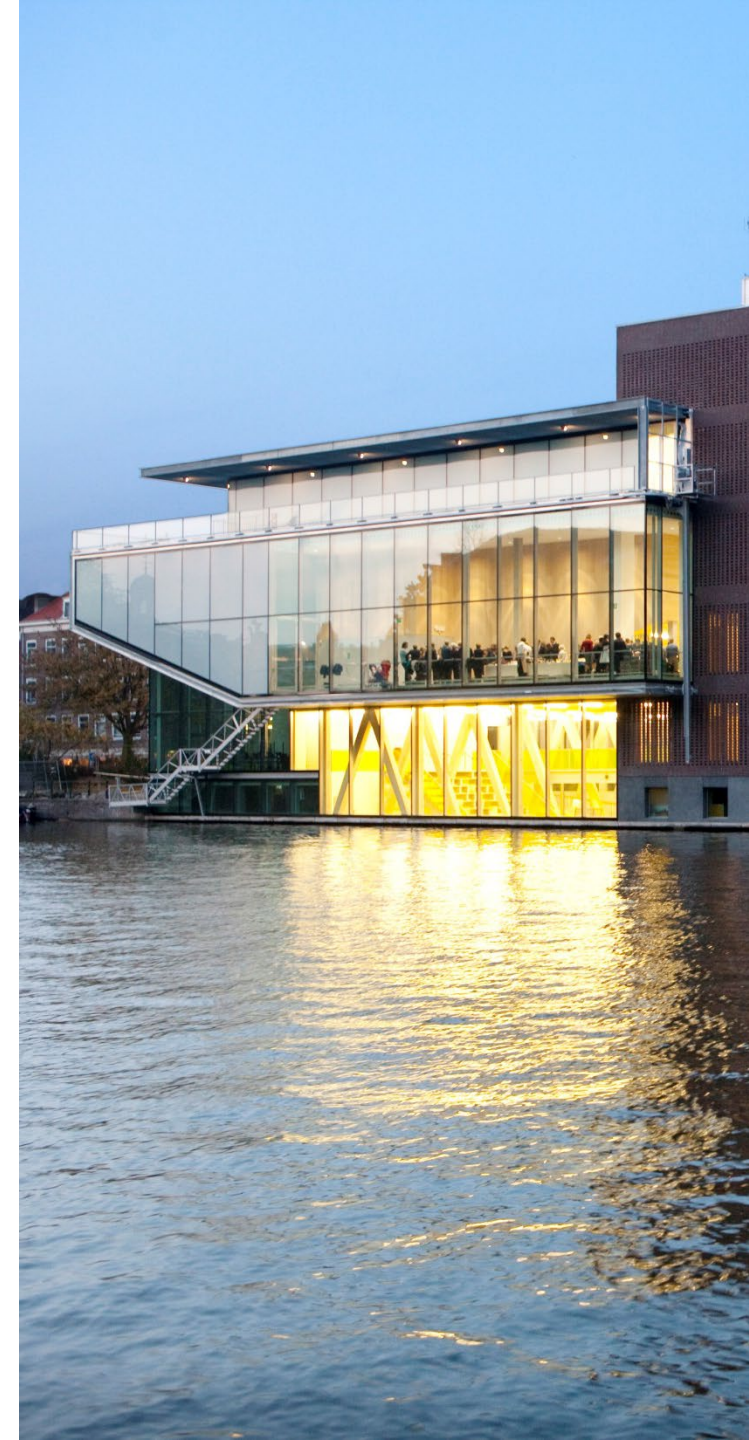

Tips for writing an ASF grant application

- Be very specific about how you would like to spend the requested funds
- Make explicit to which SDG your research would contribute, and how
- Be convincing about the theoretical novelty/potential contribution of your research
- Provide details about the methodology (e.g., experimental design, identification)
- Writing style: concise, clear, and coherent
- Look for collaboration with someone from the other school (if applicable)
